# Living Well in Finland: Essential Life Skills for Everyday Success







## Honesty and punctuality

- Honesty is valued in Finland. It's important to keep your promises and tell the truth.
- Punctuality is also important to Finns. When you have an appointment, please arrive at the agreed time. For example, if you have booked an appointment with a doctor, it is especially important to arrive on time (perhaps 10 15 minutes before).
- Time management skills are important. Make sure to register for an event only if you aim to make it. Only e.g. sudden illness is an excuse not to arrive, as organizers use a lot of resources to plan and execute events. Always inform if you cannot make it!
- Use calendars and apps for managing schedules.

### **Buying the Waltti card:**

- Have your ID and your social security number with you.
- If you do not yet have your ID number, a fictitious number will be generated.
- Waltti mobile does not give student discount.





# Walking, cycling or riding an e-scooter

- 7 main bicycle routes <u>-vaasa.fi link</u>
- Wear a helmet when cycling or riding an e-scooter and when its dusk or dark have a front and back light on!
- Different types of bicycle and pedestrian paths:
  - > Combined, where you can both ride a bicycle and walk.
  - > Pavements are only for walking. You could be fined by the police, if you e.g. cycle on the pavement.
  - If there is not a bicycle route found on your designated route you should either find an alternative route intended for bicycling or cycle on the car road





## Weather in Vaasa


### Dress according to weather.

- Woollen clothing is a good insulator
- thermal long underwear when temperature begins dropping well below 0° celcius.



- Wear layers of clothes depending on weather.
- Merino wool underlayer is excellent for warmth and comfort. It's an investment.

## **Use reflectors**

- In the dark season, a cheap life insurance is wearing reflectors!
- It is required by law that pedestrians wear reflectors after dark.

## Degree students: Student health care services

- All degree students in higher education are entitled to use the Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS). But first, pay the healthcare fee (via KELA)
- The FSHS is free of charge.
- Non-EU nationals: Your private health insurance that you took for immigration purposes, works at the Wellbeing Services County, but as long as you have registered your home municipality at DVV, you have same services as everyone else at the Wellbeing Services County.
- There is usually always a service fee (15 70 euros).
- Vocational students at Vamia have access to their student health care.

### **Visiting the H-House & registration**

You can register for your visit either with a mobile device or with a registration machine (with a Kela card, driver's licence or invitation letter) Identification even with a national passport, but with personal identification number (social security number).

By presenting the European Health Insurance Card, you can prove your **right to necessary medical treatment.**

### **Private Health Care**

- Private health care services are increasingly popular in Finland and many take private health insurances.
- You can visit a private health centre also with a Kela –card and you can get a direct, on-thespot reimbursement for your costs.
- In Vaasa some bigger options are Mehiläinen.
   Pihlajalinna and Terveystalo.
- Laboratory examinations at e.g. Fimlab or Synlab.





# Nutrition - recommendations

- In Finland we follow diet recommendation the food pyramid.
- Typical food? Meat potatoes side sallad.
- Eat the rainbow colourful foods are healthy.
- Fresh berries are our superfood –found also free in our forests and marsh lands from July – October.
- Seasonal delights: New potatoes and strawberries around Midsummer. During autumn and winter try the varieties of root vegetables and cabbages. Cheap!





Take vitamin D supplement (the sun vitamin)

Recommendation min. 10 – 20 µg (micrograms) depending on your skin tone.
